

## What the amendment says:

To the extent permitted by the constitution of the United States, the people, through their elected state representatives and state senators, may pass laws regarding abortion, including but not limited to, laws that account for circumstances of pregnancy resulting from rape or incest or circumstances of necessity to save the life of the mother.



Virtus is the brand name that identifies best practice programs designed to help prevent wrongdoing and promote "right doing" within religious organizations. The Virtus program empowers organizations and people to better control risk and improve the lives of all those who interact with the Church. When caring adults have a "healthy suspicion" about something in their surroundings, they can identify the risks to children early enough to prevent child sexual abuse from occurring. All adults are protectors of children. As adults, it is our role in the faith community to keep our eyes

and ears open and to report any suspicious activity to appropriate authorities and church officials.

If you hope to volunteer in our school, childcare center, or youth formation programs you must be VIRTUS trained! Virtus training is required for all those volunteering and work with children.

Due to Covid, the entire Virtus training process is online.

Please register at **www.virtusonline.org** to create an account by selecting *first time registrant, begin registration process*, and select organization - Kansas City in Kansas Archdiocese.

Eventually you'll select Sacred Heart, Emporia as your location.

Once you register you will then complete the required background check and sign the electronic documents: Child Protection, Harassment, Ethics policies. Please allow a minimum of 30 minutes to complete this process.

Once these documents have been completed you can access the virtual training through your Virtus account under the training tab. There is no cost to complete this process.




Sacred Heart School is seeking a licensed **Music teacher** for the 2021-2022 school year. Days and times are flexible, but could be as many as 20 hours per week.






