

#GivingTuesday this year at Sacred Heart presents us with a great opportunity to spruce up our campus and make a safer drop-off and pickup for our school children!


Our building and grounds committee has secured a bid to remove the unsightly barricade and old gates at the ends of the vacated street in front of our school, replacing them with new and functional gates that would utilize the leftover brick and stone from previous projects for the pillars, if we can raise sufficient funds.

The bid is for about \$11,000, but around \$3,000 has already been given to this project in memory of John Mears.

Teaching children to be compassionate and to willingly serve others is not as difficult as you might think. Children have a strong, natural drive to be kind and generous. The children at Sacred Heart from the desk of Child Care Center have been demonstrating the act of giving. As a service project during the month of October, in conjunction with learning about Saint Francis of Assisi, preschool and Kindergarten classes

at Sacred Heart collected items to be donated to an organization which supports animal welfare, the Dale Buck Foundation. The children were asked to bring things such as dog/cat food and treats, pet toys, blankets and towels, etc. They did an awesome job of collecting the items and these were presented to a representative of the organization and her dog "Ace" on November 6th. While celebrating and learning about Veterans Day, the children at Sacred Heart Child Care Center continued to give. To honor those currently serving our country, instead of the children bringing a personal toy from home for "show and share" they brought something to share with a soldier. Once again, they did an awesome job collecting items. They brought toothbrushes and toothpaste, toiletry items, non-perishable foods and snacks, books etc. These items were given to Emporia Main Street to create soldier care packages for local units in Kuwait and throughout the Middle East for the Holidays. Teaching children the importance of giving to others is one of the most valuable character traits we can instill in a child of God.

An automated external defibrillator (AED) is a portable electronic device that automatically diagnoses the life threatening cardiac arrhythmias of ventricular fibrillation and pulseless ventricular tachycardia, and is able to treat them through defibrillation, the application of electricity which stops the arrhythmia, allowing the heart to reestablish an effective rhythm.

With simple audio and visual commands, AEDs are designed to be simple to use for the layperson, and the use of AEDs is taught in many first aid, certified first responder, and basic life support (BLS) level cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) classes. (From Wikipedia)

Sacred Heart would like to purchase an AED for the church, the parish hall, and perhaps the office and school, too. However, they cost about \$1,500 each, and require ongoing maintenance.






To reach the online giving page through your Smartphone, scan the QR code to the left to signup & start giving! It's never been so easy & convenient to play your part in your parish's financial life!
